# SCHOOL UNIFORM

# A) FORMAL DRESS CODE

#### 1. BOYS AND GIRLS:

#### 1.1 Shirts - Winter and summer:

- 1.1.1 Long or short-sleeved white shirt.
- 1.1.2 In **summer** a short sleeve, **open neck** white shirt **without** a tie is allowed.
- 1.1.3 A tie must at all times accompany a long-sleeved shirt.
- 1.1.4 Shirt must be **TUCKED IN** at all times.
- 1.1.5 Long sleeves may be rolled up to or above the elbow.

#### 1.2 Jerseys:

- 1.2.1 Grey long sleeve with school colours or grey pullover with school colours.
- 1.2.2 A tie must at all times be worn with a long sleeve jersey.
- 1.2.4 1.2.3 No pullovers to be worn over a jersey.
- 1.2.5 No holes for fingers in jerseys.
- 1.2.6 No jersey / pullover may be tucked into skirt / pants.

#### 1.3 Blazer:

- 1.3.1 Formal school blazer gr. 8 12.
- 1.3.2 Only **OFFICIAL** school badges will be allowed on the blazer.
- 1.3.3 A tie **MUST AT ALL** times accompany a blazer.

#### 1.4 Ties:

- 1.4.1 Only official Vaalpark High School ties may be worn.
- 1.4.2 Only Matric learners may wear official Matric tie when in Grade 12.

#### 1.5 Scarves:

- 1.5.1 **ONLY** the yellow school scarf with the school name / badge is allowed in winter time.
- 1.5.2 **NO** scarves in summer date will be announced.

#### 1.6 Gloves:

1.6.1 Plain grey, maroon or black gloves only.

#### 1.7 General:

- 1.7.1 **NO** earmuffs allowed.
- 1.7.2 ONLY official Vaalpark High School beanies allowed during winter. NO beanies in the class, during assembly or in summer.
- 1.7.3 ONLY official Vaalpark High School caps are allowed during summer. It may ONLY be worn during break and after school.
- 1.7.4 **NO** other caps or hats allowed.
- 1.7.5 NO OTHER VISIBLE SHIRTS, TOPS OR PANTS ALLOWED WITH SCHOOL UNIFORM!
- 1.7.6 School bags: Only standard school bags allowed. **NO** handbags or belt bags.

#### 2. GIRLS:

#### 2.1 Summer:

- 2.1.1 Maroon skirt (max. 12cm above middle of knee, in front and in back) OR maroon school trousers WITH pull-over, jersey or blazer.
- 2.1.2 **NO** tight-fitting trousers may be worn.
- 2.1.3 If a school skirt is worn, a short black or maroon ski-pant MUST be worn under the skirt at all times!
- 2.1.4 Socks: Official school grey bobby socks or short maroon socks with school colours.

  Maroon stockings may also be worn in summer if preferred.
- 2.1.5 Shoes: Black, polishable school shoes no boots, sport shoes, sneakers or slip-ons/pumps allowed.
  NO SUEDE SHOES ALLOWED. No "sneakers" are allowed.

#### 2.2 Winter:

- 2.2.1 Maroon skirt as in summer **OR** maroon school trousers with pull-over/ jersey/ blazer.
- 2.2.2 Socks: Official school grey bobby socks with school colours or maroon school stockings.
- 2.2.3 No torn or damaged stockings.
- 2.2.4 No socks over or underneath school stockings.
- 2.2.5 Shoes: Black, polishable school shoes no boots, sport shoes, sneakers or slip-ons/pump allowed.
  NO SUEDE SHOES ALLOWED.

#### 2.3 General:

- 2.3.1 Proper underwear must be worn at all times.
- 2.3.2 **NO** coloured underwear visible under school clothes.
- 2.3.3 **NO** tight-fitting school trousers.
- 2.3.4 **NO** altered width of school skirts or trousers.
- 2.3.5 **NB NO** skirts or trousers with broken zips to be worn.

#### 3. BOYS:

#### 3.1 Summer and Winter:

- 3.1.1 Long grey trousers or grey school shorts no cut-offs.
- 3.1.2 Long grey trousers should hang neatly over the shoes. Trousers may not be altered in any way trousers may not be made shorter or narrower to create "skinnies".
- 3.1.3 Only a standard grey, brown or black belt with standard buckle.
- 3.1.4 Socks: Grey with school colours.
- 3.1.5 Shoes: Black, polishable school shoes lace up, buckle or **formal** slip-ons. **No boots, sport shoes** or casual slip-ons allowed. **NO SUEDE SHOES ALLOWED.** No sneakers allowed.

# B)SPORTSWEAR

- 1. Sportswear is the same throughout.
- 2. The school sport shirt will be used by all sport codes.
- 3. The first teams will have different gear.
- 4. The maroon school board short is used for sport activities.
- 5. PT periods: Proper shorts/track suit pants and T-shirts must be worn during the PT period (Life Orientation).
- 6. STRICTLY NO CLOTHING WITH POLITICAL OR OFFENSIVE MESSAGES / IMAGES WILL BE ALLOWED!
- 7. BOYS AND GIRLS **PLEASE TAKE NOTE**:
  - 7.1 NO Drimacs, track suit tops, T- shirts or board shorts are allowed as part of the formal school uniform.
  - 7.2 School sport shirts and board shorts must be worn to sport practice sessions.
  - 7.3 Track suits or formal school uniforms are allowed at sport meetings if you are participating, otherwise full school uniform.
  - 7.4 School sports shirts and board shorts / full school track suit may be worn to school **ON A FRIDAY**.
  - 7.5 Learners who have earned **PROVINCIAL COLOURS** whilst being a learner at Vaalpark High School, may wear it on a **FRIDAY**, but they have to obtain the proper permission to do so beforehand from **The Principal OR Deputy Principal**.
  - 7.6 **TAKE NOTE**: It is NOT allowed to mix regular school clothes and Sportswear on a Friday! **ONLY** regular school clothes or **ONLY Sportswear must be worn**.
  - 7.7 **GIRLS:** Your sport short may not be shorter than 12 cm and may not be tight-fitting.

# A) HAIR

# OUR HAIR RULES HAVE BEEN REVISED TO CONTRIBUTE TO THE "UNITAS EX VARITATE" UNITY IN DIVERSITY OF ALL LEARNERS IN OUR SCHOOL

#### 1. BOYS:

- 1.1 Short, neat, BRUSHED / COMBED!
- 1.2 May not hang over ears.
- 1.3 Fringe may not touch the eyebrows and hair in the neck may not touch the shirt collar.
- 1.4 Hair may not be further away than 4 cm from the skull. No spiked-up hair.
- 1.5 **NO** ridiculous hairstyles will be allowed.
- 1.6 'High lights' may be only **ONE** shade different from natural hair colour and only in even, thin lines.
- 1.7 Full colour only natural hair colours allowed. Hair may only be **ONE SHADE LIGHTER** or **ONE SHADE DARKER** than your own natural hair colour.
- 1.8 Comb-overs must be neatly combed at all times.

- 1.9 When the hair is pulled down or to the front, it may not touch the top of the ears or the eyebrows.
- 1.10 **NO** wool allowed in hair.
- 1.11 Plaited hair: Thin braids (1 cm), close against the head with NO loose ends in the neck must be tied with a THIN braid in the neckline. Straight lines only NO PATTERNS. Full head must be plaited not only a section of the head.
- 1.12 **NO** patterns to be cut into the hair or eyebrows.
- 1.13 Military cuts must fade in neatly.
- 1.14 NO clean cuts.
- 1.15 **NO** buns / ponytails for boys.
- 1.16 NO mohawks or duck tails.
- 1.17 Matric learners may **START** to grow hair one month prior to Matric farewell. **NO** growing of beards or nails
- 1.18 BOYS MUST BE CLEANLY SHAVEN EVERY DAY, OTHERWISE THEY MUST SHAVE AT SCHOOL WITH A RAZOR AND SHAVING CREAM PROVIDED BY THE SCHOOL.

  AFTER THE THIRD TIME A FEE MUST BE PAID FOR RAZORS AND SHAVING CREAM.

#### 2. GIRLS:

- 2.1 Hair must be neat and combed at all times.
- 2.2 Fringe may not touch the eyebrows.
- 2.3 Hair that is more than **2cm** past the collar, must be tied.
- 2.4 **Natural hair** may be tied in **4 or less** ponytails. Braids / dreadlocks may be tied in 1 or 2 ponytails only! No more than 2 ponytails allowed for braids / dreadlocks.
- 2.5 NO HAIR TO BE TIED WITH HAIR. Use a proper elastic.
- 2.6 Ribbon or any form of restrictor: plain white, maroon, grey, black or yellow same colour yellow as in the school jersey.
- 2.7 PLAIN white, maroon, grey, black or yellow headbands and hair elastics only NO decorations or bows.
- 2.8 Clips: black, white, maroon, gold, silver or yellow. No more than 5 clips allowed.
- 2.9 Beads: **ONLY** gold / silver beads, **NO** wooden beads or coloured plastic beads. No more than **5** beads allowed and no strings allowed.
- 2.10 NO FLOWERS OR ATTACHED BOWS ALLOWED IN HAIR.
- 2.11 Extensions: no wool only synthetic hair pieces with the same shade **OR ONE SHADE DIFFERENT FROM** your natural hair colour. **NO MAROON** extensions.
- 2.12 Colour: 'Highlights' only one shade different from your natural colour and only in even, thin lines. More than one colour highlights **NOT** allowed.
- 2.13 Full colour only natural hair colours allowed. Hair may only be ONE SHADE LIGHTER or ONE SHADE DARKER than your own natural hair colour.
- 2.14 No patterns or lines may be cut into hair or eyebrows.
- 2.15 NO RIDICULOUS HAIRSTYLES.
- 2.16 NO LOOSE HAIR IN THE FACE.
- 2.17 **NO** excessively large hair styles allowed.
- 2.18 Afro's no larger than 8cm.
- 2.19 Buns may only be tied at the back of the head, not exceeding **15cm in diameter and 8 cm in thickness.**
- 2..20 Braids: straight up and straight back braids may not be thicker than **1,5cm**. Block braids, twist braids and loose braids may not exceed **1cm** in thickness.

2.21 Dreadlocks: <u>NO VISIBLE WOOL</u> in dreadlocks. Length of dreadlocks must be at least 15cm from your earlobe. If dreadlocks are SHORTER than 15cm, it must be braided. Dreadlocks between 15cm and 30cm must be tied in a bun. Dreadlocks longer than 30cm can also be tied in a ponytail. THE THICKNESS OF DREADLOCKS MAY NOT EXCEED 1cm. Dreadlocks must be washed and clean at all times.

#### 3. GENERAL:

- 3.1 NO exceptions will be allowed for any cultural / religious reason.
- 3.2 Strictly NO exception will be made due to an upcoming personal function such as a wedding or any similar event!
- 3.3 **MATRIC BOYS AND GIRLS:** Alterations to hair due to matric farewell must be changed back according to normal school rules on the first school day after the farewell.

# **B)JEWELLERY**

#### 1. BOYS AND GIRLS:

- 1.1 NO rings, chains or wristbands. NO exception can be made for any organisation, culture or religion.
- 1.2 Only **one** standard watch.
- 1.3 **NO** jewellery or jewellery substitutes in any other visible piercings.
- 1.4 **NO** plasters may be used in an attempt to cover up illegal piercings.

#### 2. GIRLS:

2.1 Simple gold or silver earrings, 10c size and no additives. Earrings must be able to turn through the pierced opening.

#### OR

- 2.2 Simple gold or silver studs not bigger than the head of a match. No stones or different shaped earrings.
- 2.3 Only **ONE** earring in each ear and in the lowest hole in the earlobe.
- 2.4 No other jewellery / accessories.
- 2.5 NO BODY PIERCINGS ARE ALLOWED. NO PIERCINGS IN FACE, NECK OR ANY OTHER VISIBLE BODY PART WILL BE PERMITTED. PIERCINGS MAY ONLY BE IN EARS!

#### 3. BOYS:

- 3.1 **NO** earrings, other jewellery or accessories.
- 3.2 **NO** stretched earlobes.

# C) NAILS

#### 1. GIRLS:

- 1.1 Neat and short. May not pass the tip of the finger.
- 1.2 May apply only clear nail polish.
- 1.3 Matric girls are allowed to grow their nails for the matric farewell **one month prior**.
- 1.4 Nails must be back to normal first day of school after the farewell

#### 2. BOYS:

- 2.1 Neat and short. May not pass the tip of the finger.
- 2.2 No nail polish.
- 2.3 Matric boys are **not** allowed to grow their nails.

# D) MAKE-UP

- 1. NO MAKE-UP ALLOWED FOR GIRLS AND BOYS
- ONLY PRESCRIBED GLASSES ALLOWED.
- 3. ONLY COLOURLESS LIPGLOSS/BALM ALLOWED.
- 4. NO VISIBLE TATTOOS ALLOWED.

# E) REGULAR CLOTHES ("CIVVIE DAYS")

#### LIMITS FOR CASUAL WEAR DURING SCHOOL HOURS

(ONLY WHEN PERMISSION HAS BEEN GIVEN BY THE PRINCIPAL)

#### 1. BOYS:

- 1.1 Boys must be neatly dressed at all times / no tight fitting pants.
- 1.2 **NO** underwear may show.
- 1.3 **NO** earrings, nose / lip / eyebrow rings or any jewellery where body piercing is necessary.
- 1.4 **NO excessive** accessories.
- 1.5 No provocative patterns or pictures on clothing.
- 1.6 Formal dances: Only dark black or navy denims, or neat formal pants.

#### 2. GIRLS:

- 2.1 Tight pants may only be worn with a long top that reaches at least half way to the knees.
- 2.2 Shorts may not be shorter than **12 cm** above the knee. No tight shorts.
- 2.3 Tops must be long enough so that no part of the waist line is visible.
- 2.4 "Body shirts" may be worn as long as it is covered by another top e.g. a jersey or shirt.
- 2.5 Dresses may not be shorter than **12cm** above the knee and should not be tight fitting.
- 2.6 The back and neckline may not be unreasonably open.
- 2.7 Proper underwear must be worn at all times.
- 2.8 Underwear may not show AT ALL.
- 2.9 **NO** lip / nose / eyebrow rings or any jewellery that requires body piercings are allowed, except earrings.
- 2.10 No provocative patterns or pictures on clothing.

#### 3. GENERAL:

- 3.1 THE SAME RULES AS FOR CIVVIE DAYS APPLY TO ALL FORMAL DANCES.
- 3.2 COMPANIONS FROM OTHER SCHOOLS ARE ONLY ALLOWED IF ARRANGED PRIOR WITH THE EVENT ORGANISER / TEACHER.
- 3.3 ANY DEVIATION TO ABOVE-MENTIONED RULES WILL BE HANDLED ON MERIT.
